## **RESOLUTION NO. 2016-07-577**

Budget Amendment - Police Automation Fund (130)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASCOTTE, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 29 OF THE CITY CHARTER AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE 2015-2016 FISCAL YEAR BY INCREASING AND /OR DECREASING THE AMOUNT OF REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES WITHIN THE POLICE AUTOMATION FUND, RECEIVED AND INCURRED AFTER THE ORIGINAL BUDGET WAS APPROVED; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the original budget was approved on September 21, 2015, and

WHEREAS, a budget for the Police Automation Fund was originally not set up, and

WHEREAS, the revenue stream has been discontinued since September 2011, and

WHEREAS, there is a remaining balance carried on the books, and

WHEREAS, the intent of the budget amendment is to clear the remaining balance by assisting in the purchase of a body camera,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASCOTTE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Mascotte's Police Automation Fund Budget for the fiscal year 2015-2016 is amended as follows:

Use of Reserves - Amended \$400

Expenditures
Equipment - <\$400>

2. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, that holding in no way shall affect the remaining portion of this resolution.

6. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage by the City Council of Mascotte, Florida.
