Retail Sidewalk Sales	Up to 4 Consecutive	4	At least 60 consecutive days in between each event. Held on the premises of an existing retail City of Mascotte Business. Goods sold at sidewalk sales must be typical of those normally sold at the retail business existing on the property.
Firework Tent Sales	Up to 14 Consecutive	2	Can only be the 14 days directly preceding July 4 and the 14 days directly preceding December 31.
Auto Tent Sales	Up to 14 Consecutive	4	At least 60 consecutive days in between each event.
Special Craft Sales	Up to 14 Consecutive	4	At least 60 consecutive days in between each event. Crafts may be displayed and sold only by the artisan who created the craft.
Christmas Tree Sales	Specified Consecutive	1	From November 1 through December 25 only.

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Mobile Food Dispensing Vehicles	6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday 6:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. Friday and Saturday	Daily	Must vacate any City of Mascotte sales site each day after ceasing operation. Mobile homes, RVs, Travel Trailers and such types of units normally used to live in cannot be used. Must meet all applicable State, County and City requirements. Operation of Mobile Food Dispensing Vehicles is regulated in detail in <u>Chapter 10</u> , Article IX of the City of Mascotte Code of Ordinances. A Special Retail Use Permit may only be issued four (4) times per year to a single vendor.
Street Vendors	6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. only in each 24 hour period	Daily	Must vacate any City of Mascotte sales site each day from 10:01 p.m. until 5:59 a.m. Additional aesthetic requirements will be mandated so that the street vendor unit does not adversely affect the area in which it resides. Mobile homes, RV's. Travel Trailers and these types of units normally used to live in cannot be used.
All must address:			

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<p>1) Pedestrian safety; 2) Life safety; 3) Dedicated parking; 4) Traffic flow patterns; 5) Electric Needs; 6) Application that includes affidavit of use by the property owner; 7) Applicable Permit Fee; 8) Certification that any retail association criteria has been met; 9) Applicable fire and other inspections.</p>			
<p>Signs/Banners. Signs and banners in support of the temporary retail use will be addressed under the same application and criteria for the temporary retail use of which the sign or banner supports. Consistent with the sign code. (Article IX, Sign Regulations), the sign or banner size can be a maximum of 16 square feet for residential support and 64 square feet for commercial support. Only one sign or banner is allowed for each temporary retail use permit and the sign or banner must be installed and removed in accordance with the temporary use.</p>			
<p><i>Note:</i> If the event creates parking space needs that adversely affect adjacent residential property, the permit may be denied unless special approval is obtained from those adjacent properties that are adversely affected.</p>
